Project HomeWorks

Local Intensive Home-Rehabilitation Programme

At Project HomeWorks, we work with vulnerable persons and families in Singapore to transform their homes into a safe and sanitary state. We assist homeowners through a series of **intensive half-day sessions** powered by staff and volunteers, providing a combination of one or more of our services depending on the need.

Selection Criteria



Home Environment

- Lives in 1- or 2-room HDB flats under the Public Rental Scheme *(for applicants living in purchase flats, only those under ComCare Assistance will be considered).*
- Home environment is in need of major improvement/ rehabilitation works due to:

Infestations by pests like bedbugs



Poorly-maintained / Cluttered spaces that are unsafe to live in



Financial Resources

- **Lacks** financial means for the home rehabilitation works needed.
- Has **little or no** support from able family members.



Personal Motivation & Ability

- **Willing and able** to work with our staff and volunteers for **sustainable transformation**.

Please note that we are **NOT** able to assist homeowners who have history of verbal abuse or physical assault, or if they have substance addiction or infectious health conditions.

Does the Homeowner Need To Pay?

Our service is usually only rendered **for homeowners who are unable to afford the works at all**, and thus there is **NO payment required** of them. Instead, we encourage a **free-will contribution of any amount**.

On a **case-by-case basis**, we may still assist homeowners who can only afford partial, but not the full cost of the works needed. In this situation, we request for the homeowner or their family to **co-pay** by sharing the costs at a rate that they can afford.

Process & Roles

This process spans across **3 to 6 weeks** depending on our case load:
